ADA Title III Federal Lawsuits

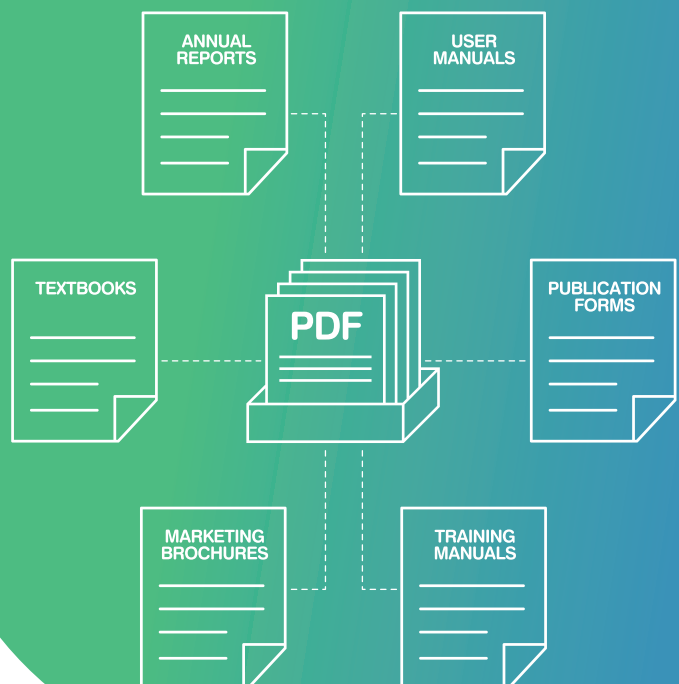
In 2019 there was an 8.8% increase in ADA Title III Federal Lawsuits from 2018, resulting in a total of over 11,000 cases.*
